Mobile Phone Policy

The Academy policy relating to mobile phones is as follows;

Students are advised not to bring mobile phones or similar devices into the Academy.

The reason is that mobile phones are small and easily lost or stolen. It is best to avoid these problems if at all possible.

There is no reason for a student to need a mobile phone during Academy times. There is a pay phone available during break and lunchtime. In an emergency, there are always phones available by asking a member of staff.

If a student chooses to bring a mobile phone into the Academy, they must be on silent and not seen at all once the student is in the classroom during lessons or registration, unless directed by the teacher. Phones must be out of reach.

If students fail to adhere to these rules, the phone will be confiscated, put in an envelope and placed in the Academy office for security.

It may then be collected by the student at 3.05 pm on the first occasion. Any repeat offences will require a parent to come into the Academy to collect the phone in person.

The Academy hopes you will be able to impress upon your child that if they possess a mobile phone and fail to follow the Academy procedures, the above action will be taken.
